At the town of Utazu, you can enjoy the calm and beautiful Seto Inland Sea from various angles



Crossing the Seto Ohashi Bridge to the first stop, Town of Utazu

Get off at the Town of Utazu and enjoy a nostalgic journey while enjoying the thrill of viewing the Seto Inland Sea, home to 3,000 large and small islands, from the train window on the Seto Ohashi Bridge



The new central district will be developed on the site of a former salt farm, incorporating youth culture. The aging rate is the lowest among the municipalities in Kagawa prefecture, and the new central district continues to develop as a district where many young people live.



The old town area flourished as a strategic point for shipping in Shikoku during the Kamakura and Muromachi periods, and the quaint townscape remains today.



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6 Kuranoyakata Triangle Residence is a symbol of the old town

This residence is a luxurious modern Japanese-style building from the early Showa period (from 1926 to 1989), and you can feel the atmosphere of the era when the Town of Utazu was prosperous.

8 Saiko-ji Temple

In the precincts, the Funayagata used by the Tadotsu clan at the end of the Edo period was relocated, and the sliding door fittings still remain as they were at the time, and it is currently used as a tea room.
A Funayagata is a luxurious boat used by feudal lords (Japanese Daimyo) who ruled west of Osaka to cross the Seto Inland Sea on their way to Edo.

10 Ubushina Shrine

The main shrine is dedicated to Taganomiya Seiden shrine, the outer shrine of Ise Grand Shrine.

The precincts are said to be the remains of the residence of Yoriyuki Hosokawa, the official domain of the third Ashikaga shogun Yoshimitsu during the Muromachi period.

21 Shotsu-ji temple Mountain summit/observation deck

Registered as a Japan Night View Heritage location

From the observation deck, you can see the dynamic Seto Ohashi Bridge and the city leading to the sea.

The observation deck fence is full of "keys of vows" that couples have hung.



22 Ao-no-yama summit/observation deck

Altitude 224m

A scenic spot overlooking the Seto Ohashi Bridge, islands in the Seto Inland Sea, and the city of Utazu.

There is also the "Ao-no-yama Mountain Top Tumulus Group", which is thought to have been built in the late Tumulus period, and you can feel the romance of ancient times.

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23 Roadside Station, Lover's Sanctuary, Utazu Rinkai Park

A perfect location to enjoy the beautiful sunset over the Seto Inland Sea and the illumination of Seto Ohashi Bridge.



5 Shikoku Aquarium recreates the underwater world unique to Shikoku

Utazu's old townhouse and Hina Dolls

An annual event where Hina dolls are displayed in about 60 private homes and shops. You can enjoy the display of Hina dolls while touring the old townscape that flourished with salt fields and the shipping industry. At the same time, there are two days where you can enjoy local specialties, food stalls, and various events.

- Holding period: Early March
- Venue: Komachi old-town area

Utazu Aloha Night

At this hula festival, you can enjoy spectacular hula and Tahitian dances against the backdrop of a panoramic view of the Seto Inland Sea. Hula dancing with the setting sun of the Seto Inland Sea in the background is moving and is a two-day event that can be enjoyed by both adults and children.

- Holding period: Around July
- Venue: 23 Utazu Rinkai Park

Utazu Event Calendar

Utazu Autumn Festival

This festival is held at the same time as the regular festivals of Ubushina Shrine and Shiogama Shrine. More than a dozen floats carrying taiko drums parade through Komachi (Old Town), a town lined with townhouses, brushing past the eaves and telephone poles.

- Holding period: Late October
- Venue: 10 Ubushina Shrine area

Sales event for agricultural, marine products, and various products


- Holding period: Around November

 Approximately 40 minutes' walk from Kotohira Station to the main shrine of Kotohira-gu Shrine, 785th stone step
 Approximately 40 minutes' walk from Kotohira-gu Shrine to Izutama Shrine, 1,368th stone step
 Approximately 80 minutes' walk from Izutama Shrine to Kotohira Station



