## Otsuka Museum of Art

Discover serenity at Chichibugahama Beach, where the sun sets over the tranquil shores, creating a breathtaking mirror effect on the shallow waters.



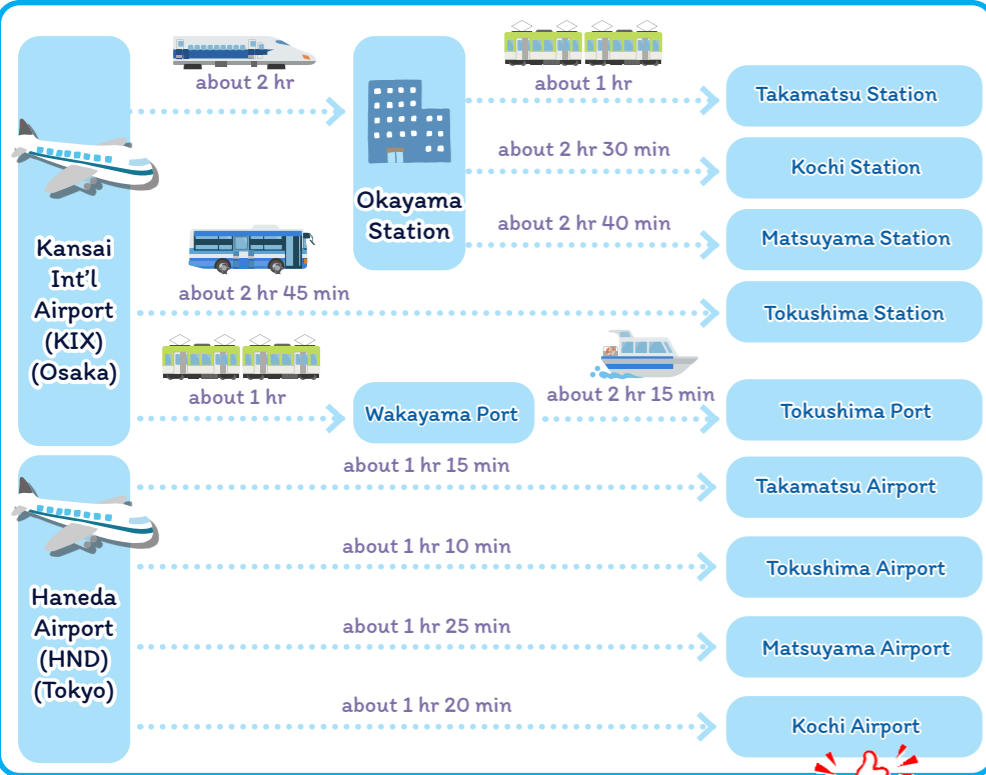

Jan	5-10°C	● Hatsumode (New Year Shrine Visits) ● Ski (until Feb)	\$	📍 Less crowded, beautiful winter scenery ⚠️ Because of snow, self-drive with care
Feb	6-11°C	● Plum Blossoms ● Winter Landscapes	\$	📍 Low travel costs, mild winter ⚠️ Because of snow, self-drive with care
Mar	9-15°C	● Shikoku Pilgrimage peak (until May) ● Cherry Blossoms (Late Mar-)	\$\$	📍 Start of cherry blossoms, mild weather ⚠️ Can be unpredictable with rain
Apr	12-18°C	● Full Cherry Blossoms, Azaleas, Wisteria	\$\$-\$\$\$\$	📍 Best time for flower lovers ⚠️ Higher travel costs due to peak season
May	16-22°C	● Golden Week (high travel demand) ● Fresh Greenery	\$\$-\$\$\$\$	📍 Great for hiking & sightseeing, Lush landscapes ⚠️ Expensive during Golden Week

Sep	22-28°C	● Red Spider Lilies	\$	📍 Summer heat fades ⚠️ Possible typhoons
Oct	15-23°C	● Shikoku Pilgrimage peak (until Nov) ● Saijo Festival (Oct 14-17) ● Niihama Taiko Festival (Oct 16-18) ● Autumn Leaves (Mountains Area)	\$\$	📍 Great for hiking & sightseeing autumn leaves ⚠️ Some festivals have large crowds
